HOLIDAY PARK

PARK INFORMATION & RULES

Hotwater Beach Holiday Park is a family owned and operated park. We want your stay here to be enjoyable and memorable. So that you can all enjoy your stay, we ask for your consideration and co-operation with respect to the park rules. These rules will help ensure that the park is enjoyed by everyone of all ages.

Arrival Time: 2.00pm (earlier arrivals may be accepted in winter).

Departure Time: No later than 10.00am.

Noise: We ask that all park visitors and campers restrict their noise level after 10.30pm and before 7.00am.

Speed: Walking pace only for ALL vehicles, the park is a place for families and small children often wander over pathways and roads.

Messages: Any messages left for visitors will be at office or on notice board.

Pets: There is a no pet policy at the park.

Visitors: All visitors must check in at the office first, and will be required to pay a small fee of \$2 per person. All visitors must leave the park at 10.00pm and visitors vehicles must be left in parking area or in the public/council carpark by beach.

Sites: Park sites are for guests' cars only, please ask your visitors to park outside of the park or (if there is space) in the visitors carpark at the office. No cars are to be parked on empty sites as this may cause disruption to incoming guests.

Refunds: Deposits are non-refundable. No refunds will be given to guests checking out of the park early due to weather disruptions. All days booked must be paid for at check-in.

Fires: Fires are not permitted in the park at any time, bbqs must be electric or gas.

Refrigeration: There are fridges in the kitchen block for guests use only. Please do not put alcohol or fishbait in these fridges. Food must be labelled clearly at all times.

Rubbish: To help us maintain our park and keep New Zealand green, there are several wheelie bins located around the park for your convenience. Please sort your rubbish into recycling bins.

Alcohol: Please do not wander around the park drinking alcohol. Alcohol must only be consumed onsite booked to guests.

Electrical Warrants: All caravans must have a current electrical warrant before connecting to the power points.

Security: We have security patrolling the park at night and they are authorised, if necessary, to remove unruly visitors to the park and instruct guests staying within the park to limit their noise.

Boats: In consideration of othe campers we ask that the flushing of boat motors be restricted to the hours between 10.00am and 4.00pm.

Smoking: Please remember that it is a offence to smoke in public areas.

We hope your stay here is very enjoyable. In order to have this park open for summer 2009 we have been limited in the amount of recreational facilities we can offer to you.

We anticipate that this park will grow and further facilities will be available to you next summer. We would welcome your feedback and any suggestions you may have to ensure that your stay is very memorable.
